## - TASTINGS NOTES -

✓ **Château Tour Séran 2001 - AOC Médoc, France - Cru Bourgeois**

« This deep ruby/purple-colored Tour Séran 2001 is a blend of 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 10% Petit Verdot. It exhibits sweet chocolate espresso notes intermixed with black currants and blackberries. Medium-bodied, pure, nicely textured, and opulent, it is a **great every day wine.**»

✓ **Château Haut Condissas 'Le Cadet' 2002 & 2003 - AOC Médoc, France - Cru Bourgeois**

« Second wine of Château Haut Condissas, this property produces wines that are the typical **modern style Medoc**, with great ripeness and intense and powerful aromas. The well balanced 2002 vintage provide full body wines with a beautiful bouquet of roasted coffee and a hint of peppery notes. The warm 2003 vintage provide dense and intense wines, with vanilla, chocolate and red berries flavors. Just delicious!»

✓ **Château Labegorce Zédé 2000 & 2003 - AOC Margaux, France - Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel**

« Located in the majestic Margaux area, this property succeeds in the difficult balance between **elegance and robustness**. The outstanding 2000 vintage provides wines that have earthy flavors of tobacco leaf, loamy soil and roasted meat, medium to full body with a really long finish. The warm 2003 vintage provides wines with distinctive fruity notes of strawberry and dry figs, medium to full body, and great silky tannins.»

✓ **Château Matras 2002 & 2004 - AOC Saint Emilion, France - Grand Cru Classé de Saint Emilion**

« Located on the breathtaking limestone terroir of St Emilion, this property produces **aromatic wines rather than powerful ones**. The classical 2002 vintage has an average intensity in the nose with floral and camphor notes. With great acidity and thin tannins, Matras 2002 is a light and harmonious wine. The Matras 2004 is light red with beautiful lightness and magnificent clarity. Aromas are of roasting coffee; floral notes (violets) and menthol. More fruity flavors (cherry) appear after aeration. The wine has silky tannins and long length. »

✓ **Château Lafon Rochet 2001 & 2003 – AOC Saint Estephe, France – Grand Cru Classé 1855**

« This St Estephe grows grapes from one of the best terroir from France. Associated with the greatest winemaking techniques, Château Lafon Rochet reflects the **pure aristocratic wines from Bordeaux**. In the ready to drink 2001 vintage, fantastic notes of leather, roasted meat and tiny vegetal notes from the Cabernet. Austere in its expression, the wine has an amazingly unctuous texture. The hot 2003 vintage provide strong intensity,; mocha and tobacco first; berries and caramel emerge when air is introduced. The elegant tannins are softened; the alcohol delicately veils the body of the wine. The attack is soft and progressive, the evolution is quite full and the finish is long and silky. Simply sublime. »

✓ **Château Rauzan Gassies 2004 – AOC Margaux, France – Grand Cru Classé 1855**

« Rauzan Gassies has more than a century of history. This wine is more about softness than strength. The 2004's saturated blue/purple color is accompanied by a bouquet of crushed rocks, white flowers, and black currants, medium body, an impressive, layered mid-palate, and a persistent finish. This is « **woman's wine** » in all its splendor. Perfectly paired with delicate and refine foods.»

✓ **Château Smith Haut Lafitte 2000 & 2002 – AOC Pessac Léognan, France – Grand Cru Classé**

« Here is the kosher version of a worldwide icon. The inimitable style of Smith Haut Lafitte is distinguished by rich toasty notes (they have their own barrel maker), the perfect maturity of the Bordeaux varietals, as well as the best attention to every winemaking details. From the outstanding 2000 vintage or the more classical 2000, **drink a legend from Bordeaux!** »

✓ **Château Smith Haut Lafitte White 2004 – AOC Pessac Léognan, France – Grand Cru Classé**

« Smith Haut Lafitte is even more famous for its white than for its red! A Sauvignon and Semillon blend fermented and aged in oak barrel, which has a very aromatic nose revealing aromas of citrus (lemon zest, grapefruit) and sweet caramel. Full bodied, it has structure and consistency. This wine has to be in every cellar as it is **the best kosher white wine** ever made.»

✓ **Château Haut Condissas 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2005 – AOC Médoc, France – Cru Bourgeois**

« Wines from Haut Condissas are coming from a selection of micro-plots isolated on the best soils of the Medoc appellation.
